Update since Ofsted

Staff have responded well to the comments about the elements of weaker teaching in the report. A School Improvement Adviser reported in April: Challenge was evident in all classes visited; Pace was clearly a focus for staff; There was evidence in all classes that teacher expectations were higher than previously seen and in Early Years, adults leading groups had high expectations of the writing children were producing and provided effective guidance. However, there are still inconsistencies across the school which we are planning for and working on.
